



2nd Annual Constable Run Regulations

to be held at The Crown Inn, Wormingford
on Sunday 13th September 2009

1. ANNOUNCEMENT. The Sunbeam Motor Cycle Club Ltd will organize the 2nd Annual Constable Run on Sunday 13th September 2009. The event will be open to any person entering a motorcycle, sidecar outfit or tricycle, manufactured prior to 31st December 1930. The event will be held under these regulations and any final instructions.

2. ENTRIES. These will be accepted only if submitted on the official entry form, accompanied by the entry fee of £10.00 if a member, or £13.00 if not a member of the organising club. A ploughman's lunch can be ordered at the time of your entry. These entry fees include Personal Accident Insurance cover for the event. If you wish to join the Sunbeam MCC and enjoy the lower fee for this event, and other veteran and vintage events throughout 2009, please include the annual subscription for 2009 of £15.

ENTRIES MUST REACH THE SECRETARY OF THE MEETING NO LATER THAN MONDAY 3rd August 2009. There can be no change of drivers once the entries have closed and machines must comply with all legal requirements, and display a current Road Fund Disc. Entry fees will only be refunded if the event is cancelled. An official programme will be sent to all entrants a week before the event and be regarded as receipt of entry.

Clothing of an advertising or comic nature is not allowed and trade plates are not permitted. The towing of period trailers behind solo machines is not permitted.

Two numbered cards will be supplied and must be conspicuously displayed throughout the event, one facing forwards mounted on the machine, the other facing rear and normally carried by the rider on his belt. These must be removed upon the conclusion of the event. Remember to bring string and/or tape to fix them.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse an entry or exclude a machine they feel is unfit to take part or likely to bring the event into disrepute.

3. PASSENGERS. Passengers may be carried on solo machines and other vehicles where proper seating is provided. The passenger must be named on the entry form and a change of the passenger en route is not permitted as it contravenes the insurance arrangements and will render the rider liable to exclusion.

4. DESCRIPTION. Entrants are required to assemble at the car park of The Crown Inn, Main Rd, Wormingford, Colchester, Essex CO6 3AB, on Sunday 13th September 2009, between 9.30 hrs and 10.30 hrs. There will be a road safety run of approx. 45 miles starting at 11.00 hrs, participation will be voluntary, but to qualify for an award entrants will be required to complete the run in accordance with these regulations and any final instructions. There will be a presentation of awards to conclude the event.

5. ROAD SAFETY RUN. This will comprise one lap of a circuit approx. 45 miles on tarmac roads with 1 reasonable hill, the start and finish being in the car park of The Crown Inn. Machines will leave at two per minute, starting at 11:00 hrs. Marshals will be on duty at all appropriate points along the route. A route sheet will be provided to all riders. Each machine must complete the course under its own power and/or that of its rider.

There is no time limit but a back marker will close the course, leaving thirty minutes after the last entrant. A breakdown service will be available and details of this will be provided in the final instructions sent to riders approximately 10 days before the event.

6. LEGAL REQUIREMENTS. Machines must comply with the legal requirements for use on the public highway. All must be covered by a current MOT Certificate and display a current Road Fund Licence. Those found to be untaxed at the start will be excluded. Riders **MUST** have valid insurance in accordance with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act and the relevant Law in Great Britain and will be required to sign a declaration that they are covered by such insurance. All riders and passengers are required to 'sign on and off'.

7. RIDING SAFETY. It is vitally important that if you break down you **MUST** get your machine off the Highway, preferably onto the hard shoulder, pavement or bank, out of the traffic stream where you can work on it or wait to be picked up. This is particularly pertinent in the narrow lanes and where the traffic stream is heavy. It is **NOT** acceptable to block your side of the road with a machine being worked on or waiting to be picked up. It is very hazardous to put yourself in a position where traffic has to deviate to avoid you, sometimes with little warning.

8. AWARDS. All are perpetual awards to be held for one year only. These awards are required to be returned to the Secretary of the Meeting at least two weeks before the running of the next event. Replicas awarded are retained by the winners.

- a) Riders choice of Best Veteran
- b) Riders choice of Best Vintage
- c) Riders choice of Best Three-wheeler
- d) Machine ridden for the greatest distance to the event.
- e) The Youngest rider.
- f) Most meritorious effort

Commemorative awards will be presented to all finishers.

- 6 I/We confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described above shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that it/they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof, have a valid MOT certificate and carry a current Road Fund Disc
- 7 I/We agree that I am/We are required to register our arrival by 'Signing On' at the designated place not less than 30 minutes prior to commencement of the event.
- 8 I/We further declare that we understand that I/We are required to 'Sign Off' as soon as possible on our return to the paddock.

Acknowledgement of the risks of motorsport:
