## The 72<sup>nd</sup> Pioneer Run® to Brighton for Veteran Motorcycles.

The Sunbeam Motor Cycle Club was founded in 1924, and promoted the first Pioneer Run to Brighton in 1930. In 2010 the Pioneer Run will be held on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> March, and will be the 72<sup>nd</sup> event.

This historic event, promoted by the Sunbeam MCC is a milestone in the veteran motor cycle movement, and will attract the largest gathering of pre-1915 solo's sidecars, tricycles and quadricycles in the world and represents a unique opportunity to see so many historic machines in action. It is anticipated that 370 or more entries will be received.

Promoted under an ACU International Permit, the event attracted more than 35 overseas entries in 2009 and it is expected that this number will be exceeded for 2010.

The 2010 Pioneer Run will started at **08:00hrs** from **Tattenham Corner, Epsom Downs** by the **Mayor of Epsom & Ewell**, and from there the 62 mile route follows the **A217 through Reigate**, to join the **A23 at Gatwick**, then diverting to **Handcross, Cowfold** and **Henfield**, to re-join the A23 after Pyecombe Hill.

The route continues **through Brighton to Madeira Drive** where the first arrivals are expected from 10:00hrs.

**Awards will be presented by the Mayor of the City of Brighton & Hove at 14:00hrs**
