- I/we confirm that I/we understand the nature and type of event we are entering and its inherent risks and agree to accept the same notwithstanding that such risks may involve negligence on the part of the organisers or officials.

- I/we confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described above shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that it/they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof, have a valid MOT certificate and carry a current Road Fund Disc.
- I/we agree that I am/we are required to register our arrival by 'Signing On' at the designated place not less than 30 minutes prior to commencement of the event.
- I/we further declare that we understand that I/we are required to 'Sign Off' as soon as possible on our return to the paddock.

18th ANNUAL NEW CONYBORO RUN

BACKGROUND: The New Conyboro Run was initiated In 1993. It was the re-introduction of an older event but taking place in a new area, starting at the Six Bells, Chiddingly in Sussex. The original event was the Sunbeam Veteran and Vintage Rally. In later years the New Conyboro Run has been opened to include machines up to 1939 provided they comply with certain restrictions. This change was made to bring the New Conyboro Run more in line with the original Veteran and Vintage Rally.

The New Conyboro Run consists of a morning run, with a short and long route option. The Six Bells is a real vehicle enthusiast's pub, with a ploughman's lunch and tea and cakes available in the afternoon.

REGULATIONS

ANNOUNCEMENT: The Sunbeam Motorcycle Club Ltd will organise the 18th Annual New Conyboro Run on Sunday 30th May 2010 in the field adjacent to 'The Six Bells' The Street, Chiddingly, East Sussex BN8 6HT. The event will be open to any persons entering a veteran, vintage or post vintage motorcycle, sidecar outfit, tricycle or three wheeler. All machines must be manufactured prior to 31st December 1939. Machines in the Post Vintage Class (January 1st 1931-December 31st 1939) must have girder forks and be structurally unaltered. All machines must comply with all legal requirements and display a current Road Fund Licence. The event will consist of a Road Safety Run. Entrants will be able to choose either of two organised routes:

Route A: A: 50 miles in a sporting mode

Route B: 30 miles in a gentle mode for veteran and lower powered machines

The event will be held under these regulations and any final instructions which may be issued.

ENTRIES: These will be accepted only if submitted on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate entry fee(s). Entry fee is £8.00 if entrant is a member of the Sunbeam MCC. Entry fee for any entrant who is not a member is £11.00. Entry fee for all passengers is £2.00. Entries must reach the Secretary of the Meeting no later than Thursday 18th May 2010. Accepted entrants will be notified of their entrant's number and any final instructions prior to the day of the event. Entry fees will only be refunded if the event is cancelled.

INSTRUCTIONS: Entrants are required to assemble in the field adjacent to 'The Six Bells Inn', The Street, Chiddingly, East Sussex BN8 6HT by 10.00 a.m. on Sunday 30th May 2010. They should park their machines on the plot marked with their entrant's number and proceed immediately to the signing on point. At that time they will be supplied with the following:

an entrant's number which must be attached prominently on the front of their machine

a route card covering their chosen route

a voting slip for use in the Concours d'Elegance competition

lunch vouchers to be exchanged for any pre-booked lunch(es) in The Six Bells

Under the direction of the marshal, the first entrant will leave the field at 11.00 a.m. Road junctions along the routes will be marked with colour coded signs as follows:

The letters SO in black on a white background – straight on

The letter L in black on a blue background – turn left

The letter R in black on a red background – turn right

Both routes finish back at the start point. Entrants must sign off when they have completed the Road Safety Run. Participation in the run is voluntary but only those entrants who have completed one of the set routes will be eligible for any award.

CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE: This competition is open only to those entrants who have completed the Road Safety Run in accordance with the Regulations and Final Instructions. Machines will be judged by the entrants using the voting slip supplied when signing on.

AWARDS: Commemorative awards will be presented to all entrants who successfully complete the Road Safety Run. In addition, the following awards will be presented:

Best Veteran Solo

The Temperance Cup

Best Vintage Solo

The Geoff Hayes Memorial Cup

Best Tricycle or Three Wheeler or Sidecar

The Sunbeam Point to Point Lightweight Cup

Best Post-Vintage

The Conyboro Post Vintage Cup

These awards will be held for one year with tankards as a replica.
