I/we accept that insurance arranged on my/our behalf by organisers of events that I/we enter specifically excludes liability between the participants. ANNOUNCEMENT: The Sunbeam Motor Cycle Club Ltd will organise the Garden of England Road Safety Run on Sunday 15th July 2018 starting at 11.00am

Start and finish is at Headcorn Airfield which is just off the A274 one mile south of Headcorn Village TN27 9HX. We will use the new route of 45 miles with an alternative route available round Tenterden. As usual our lunch stop is at the Lord Raglan, Rabbits Cross. Ploughman's Lunch is available for £8.50. We hope that entrants will not eat their own food on the pubs premises.

Entry is open to all, whether club member or not. The higher entry fee for non-members is for one day associate membership and ACU insurance. We welcome applications from new-members in which case entry will be the Members' rate.

There are four classes (a) Veteran Solos (pre 1915), (b) Vintage Solos (pre 1931) and (c) Veteran/Vintage 3-wheelers. Also (d) Post Vintage (pre 1940 structurally unmodified) Solos and 3 - wheelers together.

Machines must comply with all legal requirements.

The event will be held under these Regulations and any Final Instructions which may be issued.

Headcorn Airfield always welcomes us to their ex-wartime grass airfield which buzzes with civilian activity ranging from old Tiger Moths to modern small planes and regular parachute drops. Entrance to the airfield is free but the club will give small fee to Shenley Farms, the landowners, and make a contribution to the world-renowned Burns unit at Queen Victoria Hospital, East Grinstead.

ENTRIES: These will be accepted only if submitted on the official Entry Form accompanied by the appropriate entry fees.

Entry fee is £12.50 for Sunbeam members, and £15.50 for non-members. The cost per passenger is £2.50.

Entries must reach the Secretary of Meeting no later than Monday 6th June.

Entry fees will only be refunded if the event is cancelled.

INSTRUCTIONS: Entrants are asked to sign in as soon as possible after arriving and assemble in the paddock by 10:45am.

An entrants number will be provided when signing in and this should be attached prominently on the front of the machine.
