FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Please assemble at the venue from 9:00 am onwards, we have limited on-site parking so only participating motorcycles and tricycles can park in the grounds of the church. Please respect any requests that marshals might issue regarding access to the church yard. Trailers and support vehicles can be parked along the eastern section of Bexhill sea front which is a very short distance away.
2. Please **SIGN ON** near the church foyer as soon as you arrive, you will be given an entrants package containing the following items:
 - A card with your rider number for securing to the front of your machine, small cable ties will be included to assist with this.
 - A route sheet in the form of diagrams with mileages and signpost information. You will be provided with a route sheet. Please remember to bring your route holder to suit A4 size paper. A club member has volunteered to assist riders in the event of a breakdown or mishap, their call number is shown at the top of the route sheet.
 - A list of entrants and their machines.
 - A keepsake in the form of a token.
3. Tea and Coffee can be purchased from The Oasis Coffee Shop which is positioned diagonally opposite the church in Sea Road. Breakfast will also be available at the Coffee Shop – especially useful for those entrants travelling a considerable distance to participate.
4. The road run will commence at 10:30 am when the marshals will call you forward to start the run. The route length is 35 miles and is rural in nature and contains the associated hazards, so please ride carefully and have a good day. A refreshment stop has been arranged en-route at Scolfes Tearooms and garden in Boreham Street, this is after 24 miles and is available from 11:15 am.
5. On return, please remember to **SIGN OFF** and leave your machine in the church yard for public viewing until 1:00 pm.
6. The Oasis Coffee Shop will provide lunch for those who wish to partake on their return from the cavalcade. We would encourage you to make use of this opportunity to support a local business. Menu choice and payment for lunch will be direct with the coffee shop.
